Hello:

Thank you for your interest in participating in the **San Diego Accordion Camp** workshop extravaganza during April 5-7, 2018 at the Mangia Italiano Restaurant, 248 Third Ave., Chula Vista, CA. For years I have been teaching workshop in San Diego, at conventions, camps and in cities such as Dallas, Salt Lake City and Seattle. I am excited to bring an experience for accordionists to improve learning tools for their musicianship. I have been a professional musician since after a teen as well as teacher. My musician training has given me skills that only print lesson books and music do not take to a mastery. All musicianship grows from an understanding of the elements of music. The enrollment fee is \$180. Please sign-up by March 28, 2018.

The elements of music are melody, rhythm and harmony. In this 3-day workshop event we will use these elements to improve our:

Songs Rhythm Chord Harmony Dynamic Expression.

Timing Pitch Accuracy Song Tempo

Music reading and playing of ornaments such as *triplets, doublets, trills, tremolos, bellow* and *shake rhythms* will be found in song examples for play and study.

I am asked about music styles we may delve into in a workshop hour. Yes, we will play a beguine-rumba bass pattern, waltz from Puccini with sixteenth quads, a Cajun original theme, and Zydeco right hand patterns with fills. Yes, one of my teaching polkas, a look at Klezmer and even "Clocks" from Coldplay. The teaching points of song examples will be stressed. Moreover, treble technic finger studies and bass patterns will be included to show skill importance.

Articulation touch and feel in playing any musical motive on the accordion tied to a song's style, feel, tempo and audience appeal will be discussed. We will look at tempo as related to music styles, yes, a meter number and use in practice and playout.

Well, I believe in harmony. So I will have simple pro tool charts that are used in studio and by arrangers for you to use and take home and utilize in a repertoire. How about playing 1-2 nice big chords in your songs? Yes, every melody may be improved in its song arrangement with a few notes of fill-in or a chord at the ending to a song. You will have a binder to put teaching study materials in and also music song examples.

There will be a "Question and Answer" time for all of us to grow musically each afternoon. On Saturday, April 7th, we will include a playout time for our enjoyment and perhaps even some local accordion club friends.

My wish is that we have an opportunity to refine our skills not only for days but for years. Adults learn very well by listening and watching. The accordion workshop idea is successful and builds new friendships with other accordionists near and far. Please feel free to call me or text me at (619) 395-0454.
